It is through faith that sorrow is transformed into joy, and fear is replaced with courage. Through faith, disunity is replaced by brotherhood, and enmity is transformed into friendship.

One of the key elements that shapes the personality of a Muslim is worship. It is the expression of our gratitude for the blessings Allah the Almighty (swt) has bestowed upon us. It serves as a reminder of the purpose of our creation. It strengthens our will, protects us from evil, and guides us toward good. It instills in us the awareness that we are in the presence of our Lord at every moment of our lives.

The concept of worship is too broad to be confined to the five basic pillars of Islam. Every act performed with sincerity and devotion, seeking the pleasure of our Lord (swt), is considered an act of worship. Muslims are obligated to perform acts of worship unless they have a legitimate religious excuse. We should never allow reasons such as work, professional life, school, or holidays to prevent us from performing our acts of worship. In this regard, our Lord

Almighty (swt) states, وَاعْبُدْ رَبَّكَ حَتَّى يَأْتِيكَ الْيَقِينُ "Worship

your Lord until the inevitable comes your way." Our beloved Prophet (saw) also fulfilled his acts of worship even in the most challenging times, teaching us that life cannot be complete without worship.

## **Dear Believers!**

Another essential aspect that builds the personality of Muslims are good morals. Good morals are the measure of virtue and wisdom, goodness and faith. Our Prophet (saw) highlights this by stating: "He who rejoices when he does a good deed and grieves when he commits an evil deed is a believer."
